All attending will receive their selected interest badge on the day.

Interest Badges

During booking, you will need to choose which badge each girl would like to complete. Your unit can split amongst different badges, provided you have at least one adult per badge group and an additional adult to meet ratios if you have more than 8 in one badge group. There will be a maximum size for each badge group and these will be filled on a first come first served basis. We may have to offer alternatives if groups are oversubscribed.

Badges on offer are:

- Know Myself - My Rights
- Express Myself - Painting
- Be Well - Mindfulness
- Have Adventure - Aviator
- Skills for my future - Jobs

As a leader, please take responsibility for:

- Distributing the Parent letter and Consent form to your Brownies
- Collecting consent forms and money.

- Ensuring your group has the appropriate number of adults to adhere to the Girlguiding adult to child ratio of 1:8, when outside of the unit meeting place.
- Badge choices have been selected for all participants.
- Bringing all Consent forms with you on day.
- Looking after your unit girls throughout the day.

Brownies should wear/bring:

- Brownie uniform.
- Weather appropriate clothing, as activities will take place outside (sunhat, waterproof, suitable comfortable footwear for grass).
- Packed lunch and a drink, in a re-fillable plastic bottle (drink top ups will be available).
- Apply suncream before arriving and have with them to top up at lunch time if required.
- Named purse with money if wishing to visit the shop.

Nearer the date, Leaders will be given further information and badge selection, including staggered drop off and pick up times for their girls. Please encourage car sharing and make sure all information is passed on to the relevant parents.

Places will be filled on a first come basis with booking open till by 30th May.
