

INTOPS Participants Guidelines for Grant Applications

You might find the following helpful when applying for grants for an INTOP experience.

- Remember that you are asking someone who probably doesn't know you to give you money you won't be the only person asking them for money so you need to sell yourself. No-one has any obligation to give you money.
- Write a general letter which can be adjusted as necessary and sent to any grant giving organisation.
- Find out who in the organisation is responsible for giving grants and address them by formally by name e.g Dear Mr/Mrs/Miss/Ms Smith, unless you know them personally.
- In the letter include:
 - Your name, both first name and surname
 - Your Guide / Ranger unit and information about any other unit you help with
 - A description of the International Opportunity you have been chosen for and how much you have to raise in order to participate
 - A description of any service you will be giving and / or how the trip will add to your own development
 - o Your appreciation of any grant they are able to give you
 - A pledge to feed back on the trip when you return
- When you have completed the trip compile a short report including photos if appropriate and send to everyone who supported you financially.
