

STARTING UP A NEW UNIT

(This leaflet summarises information which is available on the Girlguiding website www.girlguiding.org.uk)

1. Starting a New Unit Grant

Who is eligible?

The grant is available for all new units and those re-opening in areas where units have been inactive for more than a year. Applications need to be submitted within **90 days** of your unit being added to GO.

What does the funding cover?

You can apply for funding to cover:

- Unit resources and equipment
- Leaders uniform
- General equipment such as first aid kit
- The first month's rent and/or deposit of the meeting venue

How much finding is available?

The maximum grant is £500

How to Apply

2. Trefoil Guild New Unit Grant

Who is eligible?

The Trefoil Guild is keen to keep in touch with local guiding by offering starter packs to any new unit, providing the application is received by the Trefoil Guild office within six months of the first meeting. A unit that has re-opened after a break of at least a year can also apply, as can any unit that has received a Starting a New Unit Grant from Girlguiding.

How much funding is available?

A maximum of £40 is awarded to a unit.

What does the funding cover?

A starter pack is made up of items you can choose from the Trading Service catalogue (excluding badges, guiding wear or regional publications) to the value of £40.

3. Girlguiding Gloucestershire New Unit and New Back to Back Unit Grant

Who is eligible?

The grant is available for new unit and new back to back units in Gloucestershire.

How much funding is available?

A maximum of £50 is awarded to a unit.
