

## Taking action in relation to the non production of unit/district/division accounts

Failure to produce accounts is a serious matter which can lead to the removal of an appointment and/or membership. It is a breach of Girlguiding policy and therefore of the Volunteer Code of Conduct, to fail to produce accounts in accordance with the Charity Commission's and Girlguiding's requirements.

Unit/District and Division accounts must be produced and reviewed as soon as possible after the end of the relevant accounting year. In Gloucestershire the accounting year ends on December 31st.

Commissioners should discuss, and agree, with leaders in their area, an appropriate date when accounts should be produced to the Commissioner/reviewer. This date, which ideally should not be later than March 31<sup>st</sup> following the end of the relevant accounting year, must be communicated to all leaders and reviewers.

After the agreed date, all attempts by Commissioners to obtain accounts and/or statements of income and expenditure, must be recorded, with date and the reasons, if any, given for not producing the accounts. All Districts / Divisions should nominate someone to support leaders with the production of accounts if needed.

After three unsuccessful attempts, the matter MUST be referred to the Chair of the County Finance Committee, who will write to the leaders(s) concerned giving a deadline for production of the accounts. Failure to respond or to comply will then be referred to the County Commissioner to be dealt with as a breach of the Volunteer Code of Conduct.

Reviewers must be made aware that serious issues with unit accounts can result in the removal of a leader's appointment and/or membership, and therefore MUST be referred without delay to the relevant Commissioner.
